CLIMATE EMERGENCY CAMDEN

CALL TO ACTION: WHAT CAMDEN COUNCIL CAN DO

LEADERSHIP: Formally declare a Climate and Biodiversity Emergency. Commit to zero carbon Camden by 2030. Commit to biodiversity targets. Tie all budgets, plans and contracts to these targets.

ENGAGE: with people in Camden. Provide truthful information on the emergency. Develop a shared vision of a positive zero-carbon, equitable, nature-rich future.

ENERGY: Cut emissions from its own and its contractors' activities. Use renewable, locally owned and generated electricity and sustainable heat.

ECONOMY: Foster the green economy. Divest the Council's pension funds from fossil fuels; reinvest in companies with the highest environmental standards.

CONSTRUCTION: Make active use of planning regulations to implement a borough-wide low carbon construction policy.

TRANSPORT: Create safe walking and cycling routes; promote car-and ride-sharing and low carbon transport. Repurpose road space to nurture people, plants and trees.

FOOD: Create new allotments and opportunities for local food production, incentivise plant-based eating. Reduce food waste and plastic packaging.

NATURE: Create green buffers and verges and connect areas where wildlife can flourish. Protect and plant more trees. Become a pesticide-free borough.

PARTNER: with the Mayor of London, London Councils, businesses, educational, cultural and health organisations to learn, inspire, share and deliver new ways of living and working.
