2. The red route west to east in the middle is Euston Road. Green indicates emergency routes. It can be seen that Judd Street and Hunter Street (now congested) and Tavistock Place (now blocked one-way experimentally) are meant to be emergency routes but have been detrimentally affected by the recent change. Current Tfl and Camden proposals for further road blocks at the north end of Judd Street and the south end of Hunter Street would adversely affect other emergency routes, namely:

Guilford Street Lansdowne Terrace Brunswick Square
