Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Camden made the above mentioned Experimental Traffic Order on 22 June 2020 under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The order will come into force on 2 July 2020. The general nature and effect of the order is as follows.

PRINCE OF WALES ROAD, NW1

In order to facilitate the construction of an eastbound cycle lane, all parking places on the north side of the carriageway will be removed between Haverstock Hill and Grafton Road. Eleven "CA-F" permit holders parking places are situated along this stretch of the road with a total length of approximately 290 metres. A motorcycle parking place, car club parking place, loading bay and a paid-for parking place would also be removed. The order also designates a prohibition on waiting by vehicles at any time along the same length of the road.

The Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the experimental order should be continued in force indefinitely. Within a period of six months beginning with the date on which the experimental order comes into force or, if the orders are varied by other orders or modified pursuant to section 10 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, beginning with the day on which the variation or modification or the latest variation or modification came into force, any person may object to the making of an order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation.

Any such objection must be made in writing, stating the grounds on which the objection is being made and sent to <u>safetravel@camden.gov.uk</u> or by post to London Borough of Camden, Culture Environment & Directorate, Transport Strategy Service, FREEPOST RSLT-RJBR-TXAA, London, WC1H 9JE. Copies of the orders and other documents related to these schemes may be inspected at <u>camden.gov.uk/recently-advertised-proposals</u> or by contacting <u>traffic.orders@camden.gov.uk</u> or at London Borough of Camden, 5 Pancras Square, N1C 4AG.

Notice is also given under s.23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 of the council's intent to convert two existing pedestrian crossings on Prince of Wales Road, east of Truro Street and west of Castle Mews, to "parallel crossings" with a crossing point for cyclists to be provided adjacent to the pedestrian crossing point.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The measures seek to respond to the safe travel and transport needs of people in Camden in light of Covid-19 by enabling them to travel more safely whilst avoiding public transport as lockdown eases in the coming weeks and months.

In anticipation of an increase in cycling, parking places will be removed on an experimental basis from the north side of Prince of Wales Road, between Haverstock Hill and Grafton Road in order to construct an eastbound cycle lane protected by flexible wands and a general prohibition on waiting by vehicles at any time will apply along the same length of road.

At bus stops we would install a mixture of bus stop bypasses and shared use bus stops. Existing zebra crossings will be converted to 'Parallel zebras' which would allow cyclists to use them and we would make small changes to islands at pedestrian crossings to allow for the eastbound cycle lane.



REASONS FOR PROCEEDING BY WAY OF AN EXPERIMENT

At the present time, restrictions on people's movements as a result of the Covid-19 crisis may render normal modes of consultation ineffective. Additionally, the current state of traffic on the affected streets may not reflect the ordinary operation of the scheme which may prevent consultees from forming a reasoned opinion over their effect.

The experimental order will be in force for a maximum period of 18 months and the council will decide whether or not to retain the scheme indefinitely before the expiration of this period. The council is required to consider any objections made over the initial 6 month period. It is anticipated that the scheme may have a longer-term utility and its operation will be evaluated whilst the experimental orders remain in force. Council officers would ideally wish to carry out a full consultation on each scheme after 12 months to elicit views from stakeholders and members of the public.

Coming into force on 2 July 2020

The Council of the London Borough of Camden, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 [1984 c. 27], and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following order:

1. Citation and commencement

1.1 This order shall come into force on 2 July 2020 and may be cited as the Camden (Prescribed Routes) (No. 9) Experimental Traffic Order 2020.

2. Interpretation

2.1 Any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

3. Revocation of Parking Places and Amendments to Waiting Restrictions

- 3.1 For as long as this order remains in force;
- 3.1.1 the Camden (Parking Places) (CA-F) Traffic Order 2012 [L.B.C. 2012 No. 6] shall have effect as though there were omitted from schedule 1 to that order, the items set out in table 1.1 of the schedule to this order, and as though there was omitted from schedule 2 to that order, the item set out in table 1.2 of the schedule to this order;
- 3.1.2 the Camden (Parking Places) (Car Clubs) Traffic Order 2012 [L.B.C. 2012 No. 26] shall have effect as though there was omitted from the schedule to that order, the item set out in table 2 of the schedule to this order;
- 3.1.3 the Camden (Loading Places) Traffic Order 2012 [L.B.C. 2012 No. 21] shall have effect as though there was omitted from the schedule to that order, the item set out in table 3 of the schedule to this order.

- 3.2 For as long as this order remains in force, the Camden (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Civil Enforcement Area) Traffic Order 2012 [L.B.C. 2012 No. 1] shall have effect as though;
- 3.2.1 there was omitted from schedule 5 to that order, the item set out in table 4 of the schedule to this order;
- 3.2.2 there was substituted for the items relating to Prince of Wales Road in Schedule 1 to that order, the items set out in table 5 of the schedule to this order.

4. Power to modify or amend this order

4.1 Pursuant to Section 10 (2) of the Act of 1984, the Director of Regeneration & Planning, Supporting Communities Directorate, or any person authorised by him may, if it appears to him or such other authorised person essential in the interest of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or in the provision of suitable and adequate parking, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this order runs, modify or suspend this order or any of the provisions in this order.
