BEDFORD ROW (south-east to north-west arm): designation of one-way working from south-east to north-west from the northern kerb line of Sandland Street, north-westwards for a distance of approximately 21 metres;

north-east side: revocation of the residents parking place outside nos. 2 – 6 Bedford Row; extension of the residents parking place outside nos. 7 and 8 Bedford Row south-eastwards by 7 metres; south-west side: revocation of the north-westernmost 8.3 metre section of the residents parking place outside no. 42 Bedford Row;

both sides: designation of a 24-hour waiting prohibition from the northern kerb line of Sandland Street north-eastwards for approximately 41 metres except where parking places are designated;

BEDFORD ROW (east to west arm): north side, designation of a 24-hour waiting prohibition between the north-eastern kerb line of the south-east to north-west arm of Bedford Row (as proposed to be built-out) and the paid-for parking place at the side of no. 1 Bedford Row

SANDLAND STREET / BEDFORD ROW (east to west arm): north side, designation of a 24-hour waiting prohibition from the junction with the south-west to north-east arm of Bedford Way, westwards for a distance of approximately 15 metres; south side: designation of a 24-hour waiting prohibition between the Car Club parking place outside nos. 47 and 48 Bedford Way and the paid-for parking place opposite nos. 18 and 19 Sandland Street (approximately 29 metres length)

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The proposed orders would designate one-way working, from south-east to northwest, along a short section of Bedford Row immediately north of its junction with Sandland Street. This section of the road will also be narrowed by the construction of a footway build-out and cycle track (enabling cyclists to travel in both directions). 24hour waiting restrictions are also proposed along this length of the road and in Sandland Street and the east to west section of Bedford Row together with the relocation of some residents parking spaces. The scheme is intended to enhance safety at the junction, prevent through traffic movements and create a safer environment for pedestrians and cyclists in accordance with the borough's sustainable transport objectives.
