The general nature and effect of the order will be to revoke sections of parking places in order to install bicycle hangars at the following locations:

LEIGHTON ROAD – removal of the easternmost 5.3m section of the residents parking place at the side of no. 55 Brecknock Road

BELSIZE AVENUE – removal of a 2.7m section of the residents parking place outside nos. 41 to 43 Belsize Avenue

BRIARDALE GARDENS – removal the south-easternmost 2.7m section of the residents parking place at the side of no. 41 Platt's Lane

HANDEL STREET – removal of a 2.7m section of the residents parking place opposite no. 4 Handel Street HUNTLEY STREET – removal of a 5m section of the residents parking place outside no. 7 Huntley Street ROUSDEN STREET – removal of the south-easternmost 2.7m section of the residents parking place outside nos. 2-9 Rousden Street

The Camden (Revocation of Parking Places) (No. 3) Traffic Order 2021

Statement of Reasons

There is a growing demand from residents living in high density dwellings, with limited space for sheltered and secure cycle parking within their properties.

A lack of secure cycle hangar storage facilities is currently a barrier to people cycling. A key objective of the Camden Transport Strategy is to improve cycling facilities for those living, visiting and working in Camden.

The Council believes the introduction of secure cycle hangar parking facilities would encourage cycling within the borough especially in locations where high density dwellings are present.

The locations identified have been identified as a suitable for the installation of safe and secure cycle hangar parking units. The traffic order proposes the removal of sections of parking places in order to install cycle hangars at the locations.

1. Citation and commencement
